The Attorney General Charitable Trust Section administers Michigan laws for registering charities, the Charitable Organizations and Solicitations Act (COSA) MCL 400.271 *et seq.* and the Supervision of Trustees for Charitable Purposes Act (STCPA), MCL 14.251 *et seq.*

It appears Make Your Date might be subject to COSA and/or STCPA. **Complete and return *CTS - 01 Initial Solicitation Registration Form* (available at [www.mi.gov/charity](http://www.mi.gov/charity)) at the earliest convenience.** The instructions include information about possible exemptions. There is no fee to register with our office.

If you believe that your organization might be exempt then you can fill out the Request for Exemption form, information on procedures and requirements, and applicable statutes may be accessed on the Attorney General website at [www.mi.gov/charity](http://www.mi.gov/charity).

This letter serves as a follow-up on our February 13, 2019 correspondence (copy enclosed) that requested you to provide certain information in order to register your organization under the Charitable Organizations and Solicitations Act (COSA) MCL 400.271 *et seq.* and the Supervision of Trustees for Charitable Purposes Act (STCPA), MCL 14.251 *et seq.* Please be advised that it is a violation of Michigan law to solicit and receive contributions and to hold charitable assets in Michigan without proper registration.

If you believe that your organization might be exempt then you can fill out the Request for Exemption form, information on procedures and requirements, and applicable statutes may be accessed on the Attorney General website at [www.mi.gov/charity](http://www.mi.gov/charity).
